



Rio Bravo Community Association Rules

Golf Cart Usage Rule

Any person, including a Member, Resident, Employee, Vendor or Guest driving or operating a golf cart on Casa Club Drive, or any future streets annexed into or adopted into the Rio Bravo Community Association, must operate the golf cart in an appropriate or safe manner that doesn't endanger the occupants of the golf cart or any other person or property. Parents, guardians or caretakers of minors, or residents allowing any guest operating a golf cart on Casa Club Drive or any other street(s) under the control of the Rio Bravo Community Association must ensure the safe operation of golf carts by those same minors or guests. The various homeowner associations within the Rio Bravo Country Club Gated Community are encouraged to adopt enforceable rules regarding the safe operation of golf carts within their respective communities. Further, Section 5.10(b) of the Rio Bravo Community Association CC&Rs defines and describes authorized access to the golf course and restricted access for all others and should be referenced within any adopted homeowner rules.
